Michael A. Pikos, DDS



Dr. Pikos is originally from Campbell, Ohio. He attended The Ohio State University where he graduated Summa Cum Laude and Phi Beta Kappa. He also graduated with honors from The Ohio State University College of Dentistry.

He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, Diplomate of the American Board of Oral Implantology/Implant Dentistry, Diplomate of the International Congress of Oral Implantologists and Diplomate

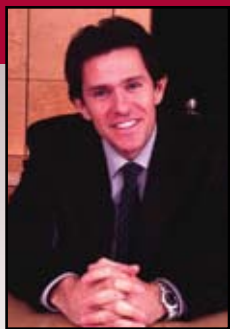
of the American Society of Osseointegration. Dr. Pikos was awarded the 2006 Aaron Gershkoff Memorial Award given by the American Academy of Implant Dentistry.

He is an Adjunct Assistant Professor, Department of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery at the following institutions: The Ohio State University, College of Dentistry, University of Miami, School of Medicine, and Nova Southeastern University, College of Dental Medicine. He is also a Courtesy Clinical Associate Professor, Department of Periodontology, at the University of Florida, College of Dentistry.

Dr. Pikos has extensive experience in implant surgery having placed more than 10,000 implants and having performed thousands of hard and soft tissue grafting procedures. He emphasizes interactive CT technology along with foundational principles of prosthetics and biomechanics that dictate the ultimate success of comprehensive implant rehabilitation.

He is a well published author who has lectured extensively on implant reconstruction in North and South America, Europe, Asia, and the Middle East. Since 1990, Dr. Pikos has been teaching advanced surgical grafting courses with alumni that now number nearly 2000, and have come from all 50 states and 27 countries. Dr. Pikos maintains a private practice in Palm Harbor, Florida which is limited exclusively to implant surgery.

Maurice A. Salama, DMD



Dr. Maurice A. Salama completed his undergraduate studies at the State University of New York at Binghamton in 1985, where he received his BS in Biology. Dr. Salama received his DMD from the University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine where he later received his dual specialty certification in Orthodontics and Periodontics, as well as implant training at the Brånemark Center at Penn. He is currently on the faculty of the University of Pennsylvania and the Medical College of Georgia as Clinical Assistant Professor of Periodontics. He

was awarded the George Coslet and Richard Chase Scholarships at the University of Pennsylvania during his post-doctoral studies.

Dr. Salama has completed an ADA accredited hospital-based General Practice Residency at Maimonides Medical Center in New York City. In 1988 he had the opportunity to further broaden his clinical horizons through externships at Hebrew University in Jerusalem and Beth Israel Hospital in New York City. His very unique background includes specialized training in Orthodontics, Periodontal Surgery, and Implant Dentistry.

Dr. Salama is an active member in the American Academy of Orthodontics, the American Academy of Periodontics, the Academy of Osseointegration, Alpha Omega International Dental Fraternity, Thomas P. Hinman Dental Society, Georgia Dental Association, and the American Dental Association. He also serves as the Dental Expert for Fox (WAGA) TV in Atlanta, Georgia on a weekly basis.

The dual nature of his specialty training makes Dr. Salama a frequent author to dental literature and a sought-after lecturer nationally and internationally.

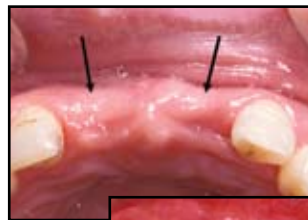
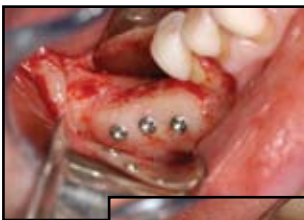

Estimate Graft

Objectives

Upon completion of the course, participants should be able to:

- Understand and apply the principles of interactive CT diagnosis and treatment planning for soft tissue and hard tissue grafting procedures.
- Successfully place implants into patients with compromised hard and soft tissue anatomy.
- Apply fundamental and comprehensive biological and biomechanical principles that dictate bone grafting surgical protocols.
- Perform advanced bone grafting procedures that will result in long term implant success.
- Describe the anatomy, biology and wound healing of periimplant tissues.
- Describe the guidelines, indications and surgical protocols for performing the following procedures: gingival grafts, subepithelial connective tissue grafts and acellular dermis matrix allografts.
- Perform common 1st and 2nd stage implant soft tissue procedures to optimize esthetics and long term maintenance.
- Understand, describe, and utilize the appropriate surgical and prosthetic principles involved for comprehensive site development in the esthetic zone.
- Describe indications and protocols for immediate vs. delayed implant placement in the esthetic zone.
- Understand extraction site management – predictable and evidence based.
- Prevent, recognize and treat mandibular block graft complications.
- Appreciate 15-year retrospective sinus graft data – evidence based including histology.
- Prevent, recognize and treat sinus graft complications - intra-operative, early post-operative and late post-operative.
- Compare ridge splitting, ridge expansion, distraction osteogenesis and GBR techniques.
- Use appropriate suture and suturing techniques related to soft tissue and hard tissue grafting.
- Understand the soft tissue grafting techniques involved for development of maxillary and mandibular edentulous arches for implant restoration.
- Prevent, recognize and treat complications related to soft tissue grafting.
